



In the picturesque old heart of Amsterdam there is a former merchant's house hidden behind an oak door and red shutters. This is where Rembrandt van Rijn lived and worked for almost twenty years of his life (from 1639 to 1658).





### The Kitchen

The old kitchen is one of the finest rooms in the Rembrandt House Museum, providing as it does a fascinating glimpse into Rembrandt's domestic life. This room, redolent of the atmosphere of the seventeenth century, is ideal for dinners or meetings.

- Dinners or meetings up to 18 guests
- The starting point of a guided tour plus an aperitif





## The Large Studio

Rembrandt's old studio is the most impressive room in the house. Rembrandt worked here for almost twenty years. It is an ideal venue for an aperitif and for studio or paint-making demonstrations that reveal Rembrandt's studio secrets. It is also possible to use this room for weddings.

- Studio and/or paint-making demonstrations and an aperitif
- Wedding ceremonies up to 30 guests





### The Auditorium



Events like receptions, lectures, large dinners and corporate presentations are staged in the new museum wing. The auditorium is an attractive modern space with a variety of facilities and possibilities.



- Receptions up to 120 guests
- Dinners up to 40 guests
- Lectures up to 60 guests
- Corporate presentations up to 60 guests



# Paint Preparation & Etching Demonstrations



When we have groups for dinners or guided tours we usually also suggest that they include one of our demonstrations as part of the programme. Our in-house experts can demonstrate how Rembrandt prepared his paintings and how he made his own paint a very interesting explanation about painting in the seventeenth century. Making etchings is another fascinating demonstration. In the museum's etching room guests can be shown the techniques and materials Rembrandt used and they can make their own prints on the etching press. They are given their prints as gifts the perfect keepsake!

- Paint demonstration up to 15 guests
- Etching demonstration up to 15 guests
- Larger groups can be split up





# Corporate Outings, Team-Building & Workshops

The Rembrandt House Museum regularly puts together stimulating and creative programmes for companies that have something to celebrate or want a day out as part of a team-building exercise. We offer exclusive guided tours combined with a Printmaking Workshop, for example, in which teams make etchings and prints from their creations under the guidance of one of the museum's instructors. The Rembrandt's Studio Secrets master class is also a popular workshop, in which the artist's techniques are revealed. With a drink and canapés this makes a corporate outing a day to remember.
